

### **Important Information**

- 1. There will be two additional seats for one girl child out of the only two girl children per unit per course subject to maximum limit of four. The additional seats will be given only for one girl child or one amongst the two girl children with no male child. The parents must submit an affidavit in the regards.
- 2. One additional seat each for student suffering from Cancer, Aids and Thalessemia. The parents must submit a certificate as a proof from National Institute like PGI, AIIMS etc.
- 3. Two additional seats for rural area students. The students must have studied in the rural school for at least five years before passing the last exam (Not in the area of Municipal committee or small town).
- 4. One additional seat for border area students over and above the sanctioned seats for various UG/PG course.
- 5. Free education to the children of persons killed in November 1984 riots and terrorist violence on Punjab.
- 6. Ten supernumerary seats are to be allocated for J & K students in UG Courses as per mail received from Education Officer, UGC dated 08-01-2019.

Application for admission on the prescribed form, appended to the Prospectus, should be submitted to the college office after the declaration of the result of the previous class or as per the schedule. No Form will be accepted after the date specified. Incomplete forms will not be considered. Students should follow the following guidelines while filling up the admission forms.

- I. The form must be filled up in the student's own handwriting.
- Every candidate must write the name of her mother along with the name of the father in the stipulated column.
- The spelling of the name of self, father and mother must be the same as recorded in the certificate/ D.M.C. of the matriculation/ previous examination passed.
- 4. Date of birth must be recorded properly with due proof. (i.e. the matriculation certificate)
- 5. If the Registration Number has been issued by P.U. Chandigarh, it must be filled in the stipulated column.
- Affix two passport size photographs at the specified places and enclose one along with the form with your name, class to which admission is being sought.
- Attested copies of the certificate/ Provisional certificate of the last examination passed/ DMC and Character certificate from the head of the institution last attended are required with the admission form.
- 8. For students belonging to the Scheduled Caste/Tribe or Backward Class, attested copy of the certificate issued by the competent authority to this effect is required.
- 9. Migration Certificate in case the candidate is coming from other universities Board/ Councils.
- Admission is on the basis of merit. The college reserves the right to refuse admission to any applicant without giving any reason.
- II. The applicants whose result is declared late may seek admission without late fee within ten days of the date on which the result is declared.
- 12. All admissions to the college are provisional and subject to approval by Panjab University, Chandigarh. The college shall not be responsible if the admission is not approved by the University and claims for refund of dues on any account, except securities, will not be entertained.
- 13. If a student is found ineligible at any stage her admission shall be cancelled and she will cease to

- remain a bonafide student of the college. Refund of any type except for the securities will not be admissible to her, as per the rules.
- 14. An affidavit in duplicate from each candidate having gap year seeking admission to the College/ Department to the effect that she was not disqualified by any Board/Body/ Council /University and she was not already registered with the Panjab University (wherever applicable), must be obtained by the concerned College/ Department before allowing admission.
- 15. That a candidate who has been placed under compartment/re-appear in one subject only at least 20% marks (Theory & Practical taken together) in the subject in which she been placed in compartment in the +2 examination conducted by the Open School Board of India shall be eligible to seek admission to the 1st Semester of B.A./B.Com/B.C.A course under 10+2+3 system of education. She should have cleared the compartment before the declaration of the first year result. If she could not submit the relevant papers/documents on the date of declaration of result then her admission will be automatically cancelled.
- 16. The candidate who is admitted in first/third/ fifth semester will be allowed to be promoted to second/fourth/sixth semester respectively. However, for promotion from second to third or from fourth to fifth semester the candidate will have to clear 50% of the total papers till that semester. It is further clarified that for calculating 50% fraction, like, 2.5, 3.5 or 4.5 will be considered as 3, 4 or 5 respectively.
- 17. The candidates coming from other Universities/ Boards/ Councils/ Bodies must bring with them, qualifying examination Certificates, at the time of admission. Migration Certificate be submitted latest by 15th of October in the University office. These certificates be verified from the Result Gazette. If Gazette is not available then student should submit an affidavit to the effect that if the documents are not found correct his/her admission to the course will be liable to be cancelled.
- 18. For admission, fraction of marks less than requisite percentage would not be rounded off to the advantage of candidates, i.e. 32.9%,39.9% and 49.9% shall not be rounded off to 33%,40% and 50% etc.
- 19. It must be ensured that the examination passed by a candidate on the basis of which she is seeking

admission to the next higher class in the Collegestands recognized by the Panjab University.

- 20. The candidate who got admission in 1st semester in a college and after completing the 1st semester could not get the admission in second semester due to one or other reason, should be given admission in second semester next year with the condition that the candidate must have attended the classes/appeared in examinations in the college in the 1st semester. To overcome this problem, few admission dates for 2nd semester should also be allotted in January i.e. one week after the Winter Break as per P.U. Academic Calendar, 2019-20. (As per Syndicate Para 49 Dated 01-05-2016)
- 21. The Vice Chancellor has allowed to change a subject in any circumstances in the even semester examination whereas she will have to clear that subject as deficient in lower semesters examination which she has changed in the higher semester for qualifying the award of Bachelor's Degree (vide Circular No.Misc./A-6/3295 dated 06.04.2018)

### **MIGRATION RULES**

- Candidates from other colleges affiliated to the Panjab University can be migrated by seeking prior permission of the two Principals after obtaining a college leaving certificate from the previous college
- 2(a) A candidate who has passed her I' semester and 2nd semester of B.A./B.Com./B.C.A Course conducted by another University/ College affiliated to another university in India under specific authorization by the University concerned, be allowed to migrate to a college affiliated to this University/ Department of Evening Studies/ University School of Open Learning in the 3rd semester/5th semester of the respective course (as per rules prescribed under Chapter XIV - 'Migration of Students' Page No. 289 to 304 of P.U. Calendar Volume-III. 2016 on the condition that such a candidate will have to clear the deficient subject/s if any, within the permissible chances. Deficiencies should be determined by the Principal/ Chairperson at the time of admission under intimation to University (i.e. on the Registration Return and examination forms) as well as to the students as per University rule No. 6 given at page 302 of P.U. Cal. Vol-III, 2016.
- (b) For migration to this college from a college affiliated to other universities, a student should submit the following certificates along with the application form:

- a.A migrationcertificatefromtheUniversity concerned.
- b. The lower examination passed certificate.
- Migration will not be permitted if the combination of subjects offered by the student does not tally with combination allowed in this college.
- Mid-term migration from any other university is not permitted. 5. When the migration of a student has been allowed, she must join the college within 15 days, otherwise the migration shall be considered as cancelled.

#### **RULES FORWITHDRAWAL**

- A student who wishes to leave the college must apply in writing to the Principal and application must be countersigned by her father or guardian. No student will be permitted to leave the college until she has cleared her college dues.
- A student has to pay the college fee and all other dues until her name is formally withdrawn. 3. Fee and other dues once paid shall not be refunded.

# ENVIRONMENT, ROAD SAFETY EDUCATION AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN & CHILDREN AND DRUG:

Environment, Road Safety Education and Violence against Women & Children and Drug is a compulsory paper, which the candidates are required to pass with at least 33% marks either in the First Year (Semester System) or in SecondYear/Third year of the Course, failing which the Degree will not be issued.

#### NOTE

- a) For B.A./ B. Com., "History & Culture of Punjab" is allowed as an option in lieu of Punjabi (Comp.) to the following categories of students:
  - I. Students who have been out of Punjab for the last 10 years.
  - II. Students who are not domicile of Punjab and have not studied Punjabi upto 10th i.e. Matriculation.
  - III. Wards of Defence Personnel and Central Govt. Employees.
  - IV. Foreigners.
- b) A candidate who has passed the following examination with pass in English as one of the subjects shall be eligible to join First Semester of B.A. and Honours degree course in a college affiliated to this University, however, a candidate who has not qualified English as one of the subjects, shall be eligible to join B.A. First Semester provisionally subject to her qualifying the deficient subject if English from the parent Board / Body / Council / University in two consecutive chances subsequent to her admission, failing which her admission to B.A. First Semester shall automatically stand cancelled.

### INFORMATION REGARDING COMPARTMENT CANDIDATES OF OTHER UNIVERSITIES:

A student of any other University who is placed in compartment in 1st Semester / 2nd Semester of B.A/ B.Com./ BCA Course be not allowed to join the 3rd and 4th Semester / 5th and 6th Semester Course of this University.

- c) A candidate who has been placed under compartment at +2 examination conducted by a Board/Body/Council/University in India shall be eligible to seek admission to the First Semester of B.A./B.Com/B.C.A./course/s she fulfills the following conditions:
  - (i) She should have been placed in compartment in one subject only:
  - (ii) He/she should have obtained at least 20% marks in the subject in which he/she had been placed in compartment and;
  - (iii) She should have obtained the requisite percentage of marks in the aggregate of examination as laid down in the relevant regulations;

#### Provided that;

- (I) A candidate joining the B.A. First Semester should have obtained at least 33% marks in the aggregate of all the subjects (including the marks obtained by her in the subject of compartment, Theory & Practical/s taken together) taken up by her at the +2 examination.
- (2) Compartment Candidates of +2 Examination seeking admission to first degree level running parallel utility oriented certificate/Diploma/ Advances Diploma and add-on Courses Programme with B.A/B.com/BCA Part-I Courses:

With a view to vocationalize the education at first-degree level during Xth plan period, parallel utility oriented certificate/Diploma/

Advanced Diploma Programs have been introduced. The candidates who are placed in compartment in +2 examination having been admitted provisionally to B.A/B.Com/Part-I Class shall also be considered to have been admitted provisionally in these courses. The eligibility requirements and Regulations/Rules for certificate/Diploma/Advanced Diploma Courses sanctioned by the U.G.C. under Career Orientation Programme to various affiliated Colleges from the admissions of 2004 as Add-on Courses for B.A./B.Com (Semester System) (1st, 2nd and 3rd) will be same as for admission to B.A./B.Com Course (Semester System)

#### MIGRATION/DEFICIENT SUBJECT(S):

- d) Any other examination recognized by the University as equivalent to (a) or (b) or (c) as given above with requisite percentage of marks given under each clause.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission to the first semester of B.Com. should have passed in the subject of English at the +2 examination and in cases where passing in English is not necessary according to the regulations of certain Boards/Bodies/Councils/Universities in India, the admission of the candidate shall be provisional and will be confirmed only after he/she has cleared the subject of English as a deficient subject from the parent Board/Body/ Council/University in two consecutive chances subsequent to her admission. In case a candidate does not clear the relevant subject at any of the two consecutive chances allowed to him/her subsequent to the date of her admission, his/her provisional admission to the course shall stand cancelled.

### Provided further that:

A candidate who has been placed under compartment in the +2 examination conducted by a Board/Bodies/Councils/University in India shall be eligible to seek admission to the First Semester of B.Com course, provided he/she fulfils the following conditions:

- She should have been placed compartment in one subject only;
- (ii) She should have obtained at least 20% marks in the subject in which he/she had been placed in compartment; and
- (iii) She should have obtained the requisite percentage of marks in the aggregate of the examination as laid down in the relevant regulations. The admission of the candidate with a compartment as indicated above shall be provisional and will be confirmed only after she has cleared the compartment in two consecutive chances subsequent to her admission. In case the candidate does not clear the compartment at any of the two consecutive chances allowed to him/her subsequent to the date of her admission, his/her provisional admission to the course shall stand cancelled.
- (B) Subject to the reservation made by the University, the admission shall be on merit. The merit for this purpose shall be determined on the basis of the score of a candidate to be computed as follows:
  - (i) Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination;
  - (ii) Add score of 4 for each of the subjects passed from the subjects referred in A(a) not exceeding 16 in total.

### **Explanation:**

In cases of a compartment candidate, eligibility shall be determined by including the marks of the subject in which the candidate has been placed under compartment.

NOTE: The candidates securing less than 20% marks in the subject of compartment at the +2 examination be made eligible to join B.A./B.Com. Part-I courses, if they cleared or secure 20% or more marks in the subject in the Supplementary Examination held in July/August, on or before the last date for admission with late fee with the permission of the Vice chancellor, provided the seat/s is/are available Syndicate para 43(xiv) meeting held on 27-01-2013).

### **B.A.HONOURS (ENGLISH)**

Admission to B.A. English (Honours) will be made on the basis of merit. A candidate who has secured at least 50% marks in elective English in B.A. I shall be eligible to join English Honours Course

### **B.A.HONOURS(PUNJABI)**

Admission to B.A. Punjabi (Honours) will be made on the basis of merit. A candidate who has secured at least 50% marks in elective Punjabi in B.A. I shall be eligible to join Punjabi Honours Course

### **B.COM.(HONOURS)**

Admission to B.Com. (Honours) in the college will be made on the basis of merit. A candidate who has secured at least 50% marks in the aggregate of B.Com. first year examination shall be eligible to join honours in B.Com. (Honours) course.

### B.C.A.

Admission of the B.C.A. Ist Semester in the college will be made on the basis of merit.

- a. A candidate who has passed the +2 examination in any discipline with at least 50% marks and passed Mathematics as one of the subjects at Matriculation examination shall be eligible to join the first year class of B.C.A. course.
- b. any other examination recognized by the Syndicate as equivalent to (a) above.

#### Provided further that:

A candidate who has been placed under compartment in the +2 examination conducted by a Board/Board/Councils/University in India shall be eligible to seek admission to the First Semester of BCA course, provided she fulfills the following conditions:-

 She should have been placed compartment in subject only;

- ii. She should have obtained at least 20% marks in the subject in which she had been placed in compartment; and
- iii. She should have obtained the requisite percentage of marks in the aggregate of the examination as laid down in the relevant regulations.

The admission of the candidate with a compartment as indicated above shall be provisional and will be confirmed only after she has cleared the compartment in two consecutive chances subsequent of her admission. In case the candidate does not clear the compartment at any of the two consecutive chances allowed to her subsequent to the date of her admission, her provisional admission to the course shall stand cancelled.

### **B.VOC**

Vocational courses are being run by college under National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) approved by University Grants Commission, New Delhi in the following streams:

- 1) Beauty and Aesthetics.
- 2) Food Processing and Preservation.
- 3) Fashion Designing.
- 4) Software Development.

These courses are offered to candidates having 10+2 from a recognized board/council in India in any stream. There is no age bar to take admission in these courses. These skill based programmes are offered at the level of certificate, diploma, advanced diploma, B.VOC. These courses offer multiple exit point to enable candidates to seek employment at any level.

Admission to P.G.D.C.A.(Semester System):-

- I) Bachelor's degree of Panjab University under 10+2+3 system of examination with atleast 50% marks in any discipline. Or
- ii) B.E./B.Tech.Or
- iii) Any other examination recognized by the Syndicate as equivalent to (i) or (ii) above.

### M.Com/M.A. English, Economics Eligibility for admission

### M.A PART I

A candidate who has passed any of the following examinations from Panjab University, or from any other

university, whose examination has been recognized as equivalent to the corresponding examination of the P.U. (Under 10+2+3 system of education) shall be eligible to join the first year (Part I) class of the M.A. course I The Admission will be strictly in order of merit. 2. For M.A., Graduation in any stream with at least 50% marks 3. For M.Com, Graduation in Commerce with at least 50% marks.

### NOTE:

- I. A candidate for M.A. Part II examination must have passed M.A. Part I examination not more than three years previously.
- II. Following mode of testing and evaluation for Post Graduate classes has been approved.
  - a. Terminal evaluation. 80%
  - b. Continuous Assessment 20%

Continuous Assessment may include written assignment, Snap Tests, participation in discussion in the class, Term papers, attendance etc.

### **CHANGE OF SUBJECTS**

Students of B.A. First Semester are permitted to change their subjects within ten days from the commencement of classes.

- I. A student should select the combination of subjects carefully. No overwriting will be accepted.
- II. If the number of students offering a permissible combination is less than 10, the Principal reserves the right to ask the students to change the combination. III. Practical subject fee will not be adjusted or refunded in case of subject change.

### Note:

- 1. The candidate securing less than 20% marks in the subject of compartment at the +2 examination be made eligible to join B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Part-I courses, if they cleared or secure 20% or more marks in the subject in the Supplementary Examination held in July/August, on or before the last date for admission with late fee with the permission of the Vice-Chancellor, provided the seat/s is/are available (Syndicate para 43 (xiv) meeting held on 27-01-2013).

# Eligibility

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Eligibility Conditions for University Examinations

- All the students are required to attend the classes regularly and punctually. They shall become eligible to appear in University examination only if the have attended the required number of lectures both in Theory and Practical classes. For University examination, a students is required to attend 75% of the delivered lectures.
- The students shall be awarded Internal Assessment on the basis of the Mid-semester tests. Any student who remains absent without the prior permission of the Principal shall be fined and shall be deemed to have scored zero in the subject(s) concerned. Any student found guilty of misconduct/using unfair means during the examination will be severely punished.
- A student appearing in the University examination shall have to secure at least 25% in the Mid-semester exams besides the requisite attendance in classes. End semester examination will be conducted by Panjab University, Chandigarh in December 2021 and May 2022. Admission form of a student shall be sent for University Examination if she fulfill the eligibility conditions.

#### Note:

- Name of the irregular students will be struck off after
- continued absence. Proper leave application should be submitted in the office.
- Students who participate in Co-curricular activities like NCC, NSS, Youth Festival etc. should be given exemption for those days which are utilized for rehearsals and functions.

#### **PASS CRITERIA** 3.

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR COMPARTMENT**

A candidate failing in any one compulsory language or an elective subject will be eligible for the compartment examination. She will be declared to have passed the examination on clearing the subject. Candidates will be allowed two consecutive chances to pass the compartment examination. A candidate who does not appear in one or such chances shall be considered to have failed and required to reappear in all the subjects at any subsequent examination of the Board University as per the current syllabus and courses laid down.

#### PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS

College students, Day scholars and Hostlers, are required to take part in games regularly. Sufficient facilities for various games and sports exist in the college campus.



### **YOGA**

A 'Yoga' centre forms part of the Physical Education and Sports Department. Under Yogi Sukh Ram Ji, classes are held during the morning hours and our teams have excelled in various competitions.



#### **NATIONAL CADET CORPS**

N.C.C. is available in the college. Minimum 40 Parades are held on Sundays and holidays during an academic year. A student is required to attend minimum 80% parades. The NCC unit trains students for military service while preparing them for 'B' and 'C' certificates.



#### **NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME**

As an alternative to N.C.C. the N.S.S. unit is also available where the students are granted opportunity to understand



the social and National problems by attending social service camps. They are made aware of their responsibility towards the society. The N.S.S. volunteer is required to put in 120 hrs of social service and attend at least one camp of approved duration.

#### **COLLEGE DISCIPLINE**

- a) Each student is issued an identity card bearing her photograph, name and roll number. All the students are required to carry their identity cards with them during their presence in the campus. If the identity card is lost, duplicate card can be issued on payment of Rs. 50/-. The identity card must be deposited back at the end of the academic session.
- b) Maintenance of academic atmosphere is expected from all.
- c) Students are not permitted to leave the college campus before 12.00 Hrs. Safety and security of the students outside the college campus is to be ensured by the parents.
- d) Moped/Scooter/Bicycles are to be parked at the stand. Defaulters will be fined.
- e) Vacant period should be spent in library.
- f) Knitting is not permitted.
- g) Visitors are allowed to meet their wards between 1200 hr to 1300 hr, only in urgency with the permission of the Principal.
- h) The college lays emphasis on the maintenance of discipline and proper decorum in and outside the class-rooms. Each student is expected to respect the rights of others, maintain the cleanliness and beauty of the physical surroundings and uphold the image of the college.
- Students must make it a habit to read the notices daily.
- j) Students are required to come to the college neatly and modestly dressed. Sleevless & low necked, short tops, low waist jeans, half pants are strictly prohibited.
- k) Students should avoid making a noise in the classrooms, verandas and other places. Movements from one class room to another should be orderly, disciplined and dignified.

### Hostel

- Disciplinary action will be taken against those students found in the canteen or moving about while their classes are going on.
- I) Right of admission and entry to the college campus is reserved.
- m) A student who is guilty of misconduct in any way shall not be eligible for a prize, scholarship, fee concession, Sports Council or other important body in the college. Students found guilty will be heavily fined & can also be suspended/ expelled from the college.
- n) The name of the student absent for more than 7 days, without permission will be struck off from the college rolls.
- o) Any change in the address of the parents/ guardian must be reported to the college office without any loss of time. A student will be punished, rusticated or expelled from the college if she directly or indirectly takes part or induces others to do so in any activity in the college for any reason whatsoever, which in the opinion of the Principal is subversive of the college discipline.

### **LEAVERULES**

- a) Leave must be applied for in advance on the prescribed forms available in the office, duly countersigned by the father/guardian.
- b) Leave upto 3 days shall be granted by the tutor and for more than 3 days by the Principal. On days of special functions/ Celebration, leave will be granted by the Principal.
- c) In case of serious illness, the leave application must be submitted, at the earliest possible, along with the Medical Certificate by a competent medical authority.
- d) The maximum leave allowed to a student during an academic year will be for 15 days only. Extra leave shall be automatically cancelled and considered as absence.

### **LIBRARY RULES**

- a) The college library has a valuable collection of books on topics of curriculum as well as general interest. It is open to all students.
- b) No student is permitted to enter the Library without the identity card.
- c) Two books are issued to a student for a period of 14 days only.
- d) The books can be re-issued for the specified period only if these are not in demand by other

- students.
- e) Reference books, text books, periodicals etc. shall not be issued except for consultation in the library premises.
- f) Books issued form the library should be kept very carefully and in no case shall pages be underlined or disfigured. If the book is already damaged in any form, it should be brought to the notice of the issuing clerk or the librarian at the time of issue; otherwise the responsibility will be of the student herself
- g) The loss of books should be reported to the Librarian before the due date otherwise the usual fine will be charged till the information is given. The borrower will be required to replace it, otherwise she will have to pay double the price of the books that cannot be replaced. Second hand books will not be accepted.
- h) The students are required to observe silence in the library and not to disturb other in any way.

### THE COLLEGE HOSTEL

- a) The college hostel is known as "Permeshwari Bai Ahuja Hostel". It has 150 seats. The seats being limited, accommodation is available on first come first serve basis for one academic year only. All students, old and new, seeking hostel accommodation, are required to fill in the hostel admission form at the time of applying for admission to the college. Medical fitness certificate by a competent authority and a certificate of good behaviour from the head of the institution last attended should also be attached to the form.
- b) The Principal reserves the right to refuse admission to any student without giving any reason.
- c) The Parents/Guardians are required to submit to the hostel the name(s) and addresses(es) of local guardian(s), visitors and relatives of the ward with their full details along with photographs specifying that they are allowed to visit their ward, may take her out & she can stay with them fora holiday when permitted to do so.

### **GENERAL RULES**

- It is compulsory for boarders to study during the study hours, play games in the games period and attend prayer meetings.
- b) The Principal/Hostel Warden reserves the right of censorship of the correspondence of the resident students.

### Hostel

- c) Allotment of rooms is done by the Hostel Warden in consultation with the Principal.
- d) Furniture will be provided to the hostlers. Each girl has to return the furniture issued to her and she will be responsible for any breakage or damage to the furniture/hostel property. e) Resident students are not allowed to keep transistors, record player, hair dryer, electric iron and other electric appliance in their rooms. If any such article is found, it shall be confiscated. Parents are requested not to give such articles to their wards.
- f) Students are expected not to bring jewellery in the hostel and advised to keep their belongings under lock and key. College will not be responsible in case there is any loss.
- g) No resident can keep a guest over night in the hostel.
- h) The boarders will make entry in the Exit and Entrance Register every time they go out and return to the hostel. If more than two holidays fall consecutively in a month, they can go to their home following the laid down procedure.
- Any resident student who comes late from home after the vacation or holidays must bring a letter from her father/guardian explaining the reasons for delay; otherwise she will be heavily fined.
- j) Residents going for shopping with their guardians will have to return by 5.00 p.m. during winters and 6.00 p.m. during summers. Shopping permission with guardians is granted for Saturday only. Right of permission is restricted.
- k) Hostel students can go to their homes with their parents/guardians only whose names along with their photographs are mentioned in the Hostel Admission form.
- Boarders should see the warden during hours fixed for the purpose and notified from time to time.
- m) Residents shall not indulge in practices and amusement that disturbs others.
- Hostel Rules/dues are subject to change by the college and such alterations shall be binding on all students.

### **MESS RULES**

 Vegetarian food at reasonable rates is served in the college hostel. Students are required to dine in the Dining hall.

- b) Themealswilhotbeservedbefore/after the fixed hours. Meals will not be served in the rooms except in cases of illness and that too only with the permission of the warden. The residents as well as the mess servants will be penalized for violating the rule.
- c) Mess charges are to be paid by the 5th of every month.
- d) Mess money deposited will not be refundable. However if there are any holidays or closure of the college due to some other reasons, the balance will be adjusted in the next month.

### **VISITORS**

- a) At the time of admission of a student to the hostel her father/guardian is required to submit a list of visitors who may be permitted to visit his ward in the hostel.
- b) Visitors whose name does not appear in the list and whose specimen signature and photographs are not given shall not be allowed.
- c) No Boarder is allowed to meet a visitor without permission of the warden.
- d) Boarders must get three passport size photographs of their own in addition to those to be pasted on the admission form. Boarders are also required to get two passport size photographs of each relative vide(a) above. e) The visitors (including ladies) will meet their wards in the visitor's room. No visitor is permitted to go to the student's room.
- f) Visitors shall observe the following schedule.
  - i) Saturday 4.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.
  - ii) Sunday 10.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.
  - No boarder should invite/allow a day scholar to come in to her room.

### **FACILITIES**

- a) Special facilities like T.V., Washer man, water cooler, Common room, Canteen and the Telephones are available for the convenience of the Hostel Residents. Lady Doctors visit the hostel for consultation. Services of Eye Specialist are also available. Uninterrupted electricity and water supply is available in the hostel.
- b) An atmosphere of mutual consideration and friendly co-operation makes the hostel an enjoyable place to live, study and relax. Proper arrangements are made to ensure that the residents are comfortable and utilize their time for studies.
